

LBI Museum Events for Summer 2017

The air-conditioned and heated LBI Museum is handicapped accessible. Limited parking is available off of Beach Avenue. All events are open to the public.

The LBI Museum is open for the season from Memorial Day weekend until Chowderfest weekend. Hours are 12-4 Saturday & Sunday in June and September; and 10-4 *seven days a week* from June 26th through September 3rd. Admission: Adults \$5, under 12 – free. The Museum is open in the off-season, by appointment, for researchers and groups of 5 or more.
